



Information clause related to personal data processing for clients and trade partners

The collector of your personal data is PLANET FOOD Sp. z o. o. Sp. K., al. Wojska Polskiego 2c, 62-800 Kalisz, phone number (62)760 07 77, email address info@planetfood.pl

Personal data provided by you will be processed for the following purposes (on a legal basis):

- **direct marketing** (legally justified PLANET FOOD Sp. o. o. Sp. K. purposes connected with running a business and expanding the market for the offered goods - Article 6, paragraph 1, point f) RODO),
- **conclusion of agreements with PLANET FOOD Sp. z o. o. Sp. K.** - (fulfilment of a contract when one party is the subject of the provided personal data, or just taking actions before entering into a contract at the request of the data subject - Article 6 (1) (b) of the GDPR),
- **fulfilling legal obligations of PLANET FOOD Sp. z o. o. Sp. K.** in particular: issuing and storing invoices / sales documents and other accounting documents, dealing with complaints (fulfilling the legal obligation of PLANET FOOD Sp.z o.o. Sp. K. - Article 6 paragraph 1 point c) RODO)
- **establishing, defending and pursuing claims** (legally justified purposes of PLANET FOOD Sp. o. o. Sp. K., connected with running a business and expanding the market for the offered goods, Article 6 paragraph 1 point f) RODO,),
- **verification of payment credibility** (legally justified purposes of PLANET FOOD Sp. o. o. Sp. K., connected with running a business and expanding the market for the offered goods, Article 6 paragraph 1 point f) RODO,).

Access to personal data will be available to a person running a business and people involved in finance and accounting in PLANET FOOD Sp. z o. o. Sp. K. and other people in the company under the controller authorizations.

The controller may entrust the processing of personal data to a processor performing services for the controller in accordance with the assigned personal data processing agreement: financial and accounting services, human resources, property protection companies, other entities in accordance with a signed personal data processing agreement (processors) and regarding a legal obligation of the processing.

Among the recipients of your personal data you may find postal companies, courier / transport companies, forwarding companies, companies providing IT support for the controller, business partners of the controller, companies providing consultancy services.

PERSONAL INFORMATION WILL NOT BE TRANSFERRED TO THIRD COUNTRIES (OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN ECONOMIC AREA)

You have the right to access your personal data, the right to rectify and delete the data, the right to limit the processing, the right to relocate the data to a different administrator, and the right to lodge a complaint about processing personal data (unless the general law states otherwise)

Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the contract implementation. You are obliged to provide them and the consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to enter into a contract.

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
